## **CARE OF STRIPE WORK**

Here are guidelines for the care of your pinstripe or artwork that has been applied over an existing surface. Realizing that nothing lasts forever (except taxes), these steps will aid in the longevity of your investment.

1. No car washes or high pressure spray for 30 days. Hand wash is OK after 48 hours. Car washes in general are not good for your vehicle's paint. But, I must admit, it's a convenient option to have when in a hurry.
2. No wax over pinstripe or artwork for 30 days, it interferes with the curing process. Afterwards, straight wax or a Teflon coating should be used for protection. Avoid polishes or a cleaner/wax product. These will remove a fine layer of paint when used. If in the future, you have any overspray or fallout on your vehicle that you wish to remove, caution should be used when going over paintwork. This paint is quite durable, but not bullet proof.
3. Avoid harsh chemicals, such as gasoline (ex. striped motorcycle tank), lacquer thinner, jet fuel, napalm, it will damage work.
